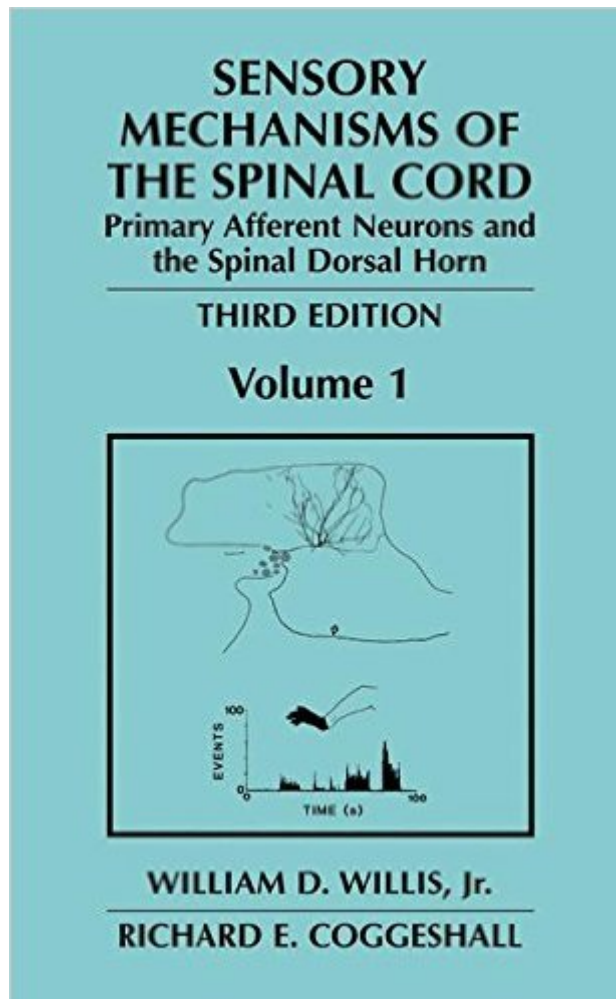


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Sensory Mechanisms Of The Spinal Cord: Volume 1 Primary Afferent Neurons And The Spinal Dorsal Horn

The third edition of this monograph continues to have the goal of providing an overview of current thought about the spinal cord mechanisms that are responsible for sensory processing. Chapters 3 and 4 in the previous edition have been subdivided, and now the morphology of primary afferent neurons of the dorsal root ganglia is described in Chapter 3 and the chemical neuroanatomy 4. The description of the dorsal horn in the previous Chapter 4 of these neurons in Chapter is now included in Chapter 5, and the chemical neuroanatomy of the dorsal horn in Chapter 6.
